In his special address, he rightly motivated the students by asking questions and eliciting answers from them.

for its onwards march. We should be adept in trying adventurous strategies. He quoted the proverbial jargon, followed in the Silicon Valley, where many of our IITians are employed. Employees who have not made any mistake in a duration of 3 years, will be fired out. Learning through mistakes enables one to be highly strategic in his functioning. With this introduction the Chief Guest came out with the following suggestions and instructions to the students:-



- The students should learn beyond curriculum. Extra reading and learning can bring them to limelight.
- As technical students they must be very confident in handling all equipments. If only they, excel in practical knowledge they can be successful technicians.
- The students must develop potentiality to encounter any challenge. Moral strength, as desired by Mahakavi Bharathi, is the good asset to the students, which is sadly absent in many adults.

- Students must develop love for the downtrodden and destitutes. He quoted Tagore's prayer to God, to convert his love into fruitful service. The love must be exposed in proper actions ie. Real service to others.



- Educationists must come out with a proper panacea to the long-felt problems of dishonesty, irresponsibility, brazenness and cowardice. He expressed his pains that at times "remedy is worse than medicine". Quality of Education which has been degraded by the Educationists' fear, should be upgraded with sincere effort and involvement. This requires the joint venture of the students, educationists and the rulers.
- Ability to fight against the mistakes, should be the sign of the educated people.
- The students must know to respond and how to respond. They must answer the questions in complete form, carefully adding the units, value, year and the like. Chorus answers are to be avoided.
- Concentration and comprehension must be the two sides of their learning. Whatever they study should be understood well by them.
- Students must know the assessing techniques. The basic and fundamental facts must be mastered by them.
- Humans, especially students and teachers must have the sensibility to understand the inner meaning embedded in the message. Reading between the lines becomes possible to those who are earnest and sensitive.
- He quoted the poem "உலகெலாம் உணர்ந்தோதற்கரியவன்" in Periapuranam comprising 63 letters implying the 63 saiva devotees.
- Everyone is having innate talents that are inherent. We must realize this and use them positively.
- It is very essential for the students to develop analytical mind and communication skill to express their ideas and thoughts well.
